

MASTERS OF THE EARTH – CHARACTER BIOS:

Jasmine Corzo – Nineteen, female, long black curly hair, light skin, brown eyes, tall, slim

Hard for her to move past feelings or emotions to do things, strength comes from her compassion and positive attitude, hides deep feelings from others in general

Telekinesis

Jasmine is going to college for her gen eds, wants to help people but isn't sure what career she wants to pursue. Her superpowers manifested during puberty, and since the age of twelve she has struggled to hide them from the world, including her own family. She moved away to go to college so that her parents and her little sister, Autumn, wouldn't find out about them and hopes to learn to control them enough to simply live a normal life without ever having to use them. She fears getting too close to anyone because she doesn't want to accidentally hurt or scare someone, or, (even worse) have her secret exposed to the world.

Quint Warde – Twenty-five, male, very short sandy blonde hair, scarred Caucasian skin, hazel eyes, tall, very muscular

Sometimes quick-tempered, very loyal to loved ones and quick to defend them no matter what, sometimes he leads and sometimes he follows, sometimes stubborn, very flexible

Kinetic energy absorption

Quint is a construction worker who is the manager of a team of laborers. He discovered his power during an accident late at night when everyone else had gone home and a wall fell on him. He is a dedicated employee who is doing his best to get ahead and bosses and fellow workers all like him for his flexibility and work ethic. Quint is engaged to his high school sweetheart, Isabella, and she is the only person in the world who knows about his power. She has encouraged him to seek help discreetly, but he does not want anyone else to know about it, and doesn't see why he should tell anyone else since he's never had a problem with it before.

Keagan “K” Rhodes – Twenty-seven, male, short brown hair, tan skin, brown eyes, tall, lean and built

Steadfast, VERY focused on the task at hand, contemplative, thinks about the big picture, tends to be arrogant, stubborn, and judgmental, ends justify the means, has his own moral code

Shatterpoint vision, super-aiming, sensing emotions

Keagan is a man without a family who grew up in a rough neighborhood. He has been in prison and juvenile detention several times and has only recently realized the true extent of his powers. He is still trying to decide whether he wants to use them good or for ill and has

experimented with both. Currently, he is working for a private security company training their employees in hand-to-hand techniques, but he is restless and yearns for more important work that can make use of his talents.

Mary Anne Dixon (Galtiers is her maiden name) – Fifty-five, female, short black/gray hair, light skin, brown eyes, medium height, medium build, average strength

Kind-hearted person, but when stirred to wrath is terrifying, protective, opinionated, once she's written you off it is nearly impossible to convince her of anything, doesn't suffer fools

Teleportation, withstanding extreme temperatures

Married to Atlas, Mary Anne is a devoted wife and a dedicated high school teacher. She has always wanted children but she and Atlas have been unable to have them. They would consider adopting, but because of their powers they both believe that their childlessness is for the best. Mary Anne believes that their powers are a gift and that they could be used to help many, many people, but that for now it is best to hide them from others. She looks forward to the day when she can reveal her powers to others, but also is nervous about how they will affect the world.

Atlas Dixon – Fifty-six, male, short brown/gray hair, tan skin, brown eyes, medium height, large build, slightly chubby but muscular

A gentle giant, well-meaning, tired of living on the outside of society, stresses self-control above all else, gets cranky and volatile when stressed or backed into a corner

Disease immunity, material mimicry

Married to Mary Anne, Atlas struggles to keep his power under wraps. He is a doting husband and a decorated police officer, and he has used his powers regularly to help others in life-threatening situations, a fact he has kept secret from his wife and from his coworkers on the police department. He is glad that he and Mary Anne do not have children because he does not want that much responsibility, nor does he think it would be fair to try to raise children in a household run by two super-powered parents. He trusts that if society found out about them, they would be fair in how they are treated.

Jason Finnick – Twenty-two, male, sandy blonde hair, Caucasian, green eyes, medium height, medium build, fit

Charming, protective, likes to smile, rough around the edges, hot-headed, single-minded, stubborn, loyal to Atlas and Mary Anne to a fault, wants to help others and show off his powers

Energy beam projection

An energetic young person, Jason discovered his powers at an early age and his parents immediately turned him over to the local authorities. Jason escaped and has been on the run ever since...until he ran into Atlas and Mary Anne, that is. He now uses his gifts to help them find other super-powered humans in an effort to unite them and help them better understand their abilities and their place in the world.

Nate Grossman – Twenty-one, male, black hair, brown skin, brown eyes, medium height, moderate build, mostly fit

Sonic scream

Obsessed with Jenny, enjoys powers, not sure what to do in life

Jenny Whitman – Nineteen, female, blonde hair, Caucasian, blue eyes, short, fit

Mind-reading

Happy, bubbly, cheerful, friendly

Candice Dunham – Twenty-four, female, Caucasian, freckles on her face, green eyes, short, sandy-blonde hair, medium height, thin

Power-sensing ability, location sensing (if she sees a pic of them), and senses power levels. She can't know names, type of power, or much else other than that they have a power and she can know where they are once she sees a picture of them. She also has a near-super complete memory of people with powers and never forgets a face.

Introverted TO THE MAX!

Chuck Anderson – fifty, male, bald, blonde beard, Caucasian, blue eyes, short, medium build, mostly fit,

Healing powers (self and others)

Divorced, nice guy, looking to fit in, not really excited to have to fight anyone, doesn't like K's style of training, works part time as a truck driver, helps Atlas with construction during his off-days, only partially on board with the plan Atlas has in mind, but cares for the family and doesn't want them to get hurt.

Isabella "Bella" Valdez – Twenty-five, female, long dark-brown hair, Caucasian, hazel eyes, slightly shorter than average, small build, fit

No powers – she’s a regular gal

Engaged to Quint, Isabella has known about Quint’s abilities for years now. Optimistic and thoughtful, she loves to cook food and loves to eat it even more (but she often feels guilty for indulging and therefore works out a lot). She’s utterly loyal to Quint and refuses to believe bad things about anyone, which occasionally brings her into conflict with the people around her and makes her overly trusting. She’s excited that Quint will have a chance to exercise his powers in ways he never has had before.

Logan Fisher – Nineteen, male, curly jet-black hair, dark brown eyes, Caucasian, tall, lanky, pale complexion due to malnourishment

Flight/levitation

Relatively unskilled, Logan has not had any significant training before now. His life on the streets has made him distant and generally unhappy. He wants to learn how to use his powers, but is not used to having to push himself, and does not like to be told what to do by people he doesn’t respect. He feels he should be able to use his powers for personal gain once in a while.

Michael Ramos – Twenty, male, short black hair, Hispanic, dark brown eyes, medium height, thin because he often forgets to eat

Psychometry/super-memory

Suffers from delirium, almost always accompanied by his mother (who brought him to the Dixon residence), desperately wants to fit in somewhere, struggles to form new relationships

John Tecumseh “J.T.” McLauren – Twenty-eight, male, blonde military-style haircut, beard, blue eyes, slightly short and muscular from his military training

Wind/implosion/vacuum powers

Former Army, discharged from military due to extreme PTSD, gruff personality, doesn’t like authority figures, not married, estranged father lives in Ohio

Dewayne McCubrey – Twenty, male, buzz-shave (black hair), goatee, African-American, tall, muscular, built

Four extra arms; the human spider

Somewhat aggressive, loves to swear, spends a lot of time downtown with a gang, wants to develop powers for his own personal use, has contempt for kind people and for those weaker than him, likes to lift weights, lives with his aunt and her five kids downtown

Robert “Robby” Kuper – Thirty-six, male, Mohawk dyed purple, red, and orange, multiple colors of contact lenses, multiple facial piercings and tattoos, slightly pale and thin due to tobacco habit

Controlling earth

A tattoo artist, leads a party life of drink and possibly drugs, has never really experimented with his powers but he has some idea of how to use them, considers himself above reproach, which is obviously not true, loves to annoy people with bad jokes, no steady girlfriend, no kids (that he knows about)

Erica Joy-Hipkins – Thirty-seven, female, long white hair, pale complexion, pale-blue eyes, medium height, medium build

Cryo-kinesis

An artist who works with ice sculptures, very flighty and particular, like most artists, has an overinflated sense of her own importance, much better with children than adults, and loves to help out at the local elementary school, divorced twice, still somewhat close with ex-husband Jeremy Hipkins who lives in Holdrege

Melinda Gains – Twenty-six, female, long curly red hair, bright green eyes, white skin with freckles, medium height, reasonably fit

Cryo-kinesis

Confident, optimist, self-assertive, enjoys life, has family in Holdrege to the north (father, mother, grandfather, younger brother 15-yrs), wants to become a part of the Dixon family and further the cause.

Ava Moore – Seventeen, female, medium-length purple-dyed straight hair, one lip piercing, wears different colors of lipstick and nail polish, multi-ethnic, short,

Slightly clairvoyant

Very nervous, wants to quit, but she needs a place to stay and this is the only place that will take her, Jason found her in an alley and gave her the address, not much is known about her

life before, likes to wear hoodies, ran away from a wonderful family because she foresaw the death of her infant brother Kevin in a car accident and didn't want to experience it.

Special Agent Symon Haller – Forty-five, male, thick gray hair, deep brown eyes, wears glasses, tan skin, tall, fit

SAICOD Special Agent

Symon has popped up a few times now to different members of Team Dixon, making them nervous. He claims to be an FBI Agent, but K's investigation has revealed him to be an agent of the top-secret government agency SAICOD (Special Abilities Identification and Containment Operations Division).
